"To Contemplate the Face of Christ with Mary"

The Diocesan Rosary Congress, called for by Bishop Brendan, is a time of intense prayer before our Lord in the Blessed Sacrament during Adoration, using the Holy Rosary to pray "in reparation for the recent scandals [in the Church] and imploring God's mercy on our country."

During the week of October 7-13, the Bishop has asked for a Rosary to be said in front of the Blessed Sacrament every single hour during this week, and he is asking all of us to take part.

So what can you do? In our parish, we will move Adoration from the first week of the month to coincide with the Bishop's request. Adoration will begin Thursday, October 10, at 6:00pm and conclude Friday, October 11, at 5:00pm. The SAS students will also pray a Rosary on Thursday morning in front of the Blessed Sacrament at 9:30am in the Church.

There is a sign up sheet in the back of the church. Families and groups, as well as individuals, are welcome and encouraged to come say the Rosary together before the Blessed Sacrament. The chapel can hold quite a few people, so please don't feel like you can't come if someone is already signed up for a time.

The more people, the more powerful our prayers!
