~~Based upon an "Alice in Wonderland" theme (for inclusion the Jabberwocky Puzzle Chest), these "Late for Tea" puzzleboxes are representations of the clock/watch the rabbit carries while running late for the tea party. Unfortunately, no watch chains were attached, as they could not be accommodated within the chest.~~



~~This box measures 3 x 3 x 3 inches, and is hand crafted from redheart, with exotic burl faceplates and bloodwood border frames. Boxes for inclusion in the chest were crafted from wenge and bocote, with gold leaf inlays.~~

~~Both clock hands rotate freely to manipulate internal mechanics of this puzzle, and in some ways, solving it is similar to picking a safe. The sound and feel of clock hand~~

~~movements play some small role in deducing additional clues that point to its solution. Once solved, its faceplate removes to reveal the first of two hidden compartments, with the secondary compartment containing a brass coin with the Stickman logo.~~



~~This puzzle is of moderate difficulty, and requires a minimum of at least 10 steps. It comes with a 9 page fully illustrated instruction book, and was limited in edition to only 50 copies (with 20 reserved for the Jabberwocky Puzzle Chest).~~
