Leona Gertrude Tennant, 83, of Bad Axe died Wednesday evening, Jan. 23, 2002, at the Huron County Medical Care Facility after a long illness. She was born Feb. 12, 1918, in Grindstone City, daughter of the late John and Phebe (Dowing) MacFadden. Leona MacFadden and Earle Tennant were married Dec. 27, 1954, in Pigeon. He preceded her in death on April 27, 1984.
