Weekday mornings are spent working at the camp that services 60 to 80 Dominican children ages 8 to 14.

Afternoons are spent with the Dominican teen leaders doing service learning and community building: Working together to address human and community needs.

Sample of the responsibilities and activities that teen leaders will undertake:

- Support the teachers by helping students pay attention and stay engaged
- Participate in group discussion
- Lead small group projects
- Provide one-on-one support
- Assist teachers in planning the daily activities
- Coordinate activities with Dominican counterparts
- Lead daily workshops ("talleres") in:
 - Visual Arts
 - Dance
 - Music/Theatre
 - Sports





When not working hard at the camp and the various community service projects teen leaders will take excursions to local scenic and historic places, spend a day and night exploring the colonial zone of Santo Domingo and take a weekend getaway to visit the natural wonders of the Caribbean island.
