At last, we have a calendar of activities! I have been working with Hillcrest since pandemic restrictions began to lift and we will be able to use the Meeting House for our summer member/community meeting. Here's what is happening for the rest of our LVHS calendar year.

The LVHS will participate at La Verne Heritage Park on **Saturday, April 9th**, for their Spring Fling Vendor Faire from 10am-3pm. We'll be selling t-shirts, books, and vintage treasures. We look forward to more collaborative activities with the La Verne Heritage Foundation. The park is located at 5001 Via De Mansion in north La Verne.

On **Saturday, April 23rd**, from 8am-12pm, the LVHS will be at the Community Yard Sale in the Bonita High School parking lot. We have four tables and LOTS of things to sell. Come buy marmalade, La Verne books, t-shirts, and, of course, yard sale items. All proceeds will go toward restoring the 1938 International truck. A flyer is attached.

On **Saturday, May 21**st, the LVHS is co-sponsoring its "Get on the Bus" tours with Hillcrest. We will assign one tour to Woods Community residents, another to Hillcrest residents, and a third to LVHS members.
