<u>REGISTER THE TEAM</u>: (Share this info with coordinators and bookkeepers.)

- a. The deadline for completed and <u>PAID</u> State Tournament registrations is **FRIDAY, MARCH 9.** Due to program printing deadlines the State competition schedule must be completed by the due date and only paid registered teams will be included on the schedule.
- b. Whoever registers the team will need the following:
 - 1) This paper
 - 2) The page titled: "Registering Your Team for the State Tournament"
 - 3) The page titled: "Worker Registration Worksheet"
 - 4) Information about any scheduling issues
- c. To register for the State Tournament, eligible teams must go to the national website (www.odysseyofthemind.com). You will need your membership number, school zip code, and the individual team log in information. If you don't know it, send Freda an email. Once in the registration you will have the opportunity to change coaching details and detail <u>any scheduling issues/conflicts</u>. You will NOT be able to change the roster except to add members if you're at less than seven. You will have to register a State Worker INCLUDING A CORRECT EMAIL.
- d. FOLLOW THE DIRECTIONS ON THE BRIGHT ORANGE PAPER.
- e. Any state qualified teams with unpaid registrations after **Friday, March 9**, may be considered as dropped and deleted (UN-Qualified) from the State Registration site.
- f. State Registrations can be paid in the following methods:
 ☆ Credit Card (PayPal) most popular, easiest, and quickest method (\$3 additional fee per team)
 ☆ Check <u>SEND WITH PAYMENT BY MONDAY</u>.
- g. <u>**PRIMARY TEAMS**</u> also must have a completed State registration to perform in the tournament. They will add a worker and update coach info just as the other teams. That will complete their registration. THERE IS NO TOURNAMENT FEE FOR PRIMARY PROBLEM TEAMS.

HAVE TEAM MEETING AND DECIDE HOUSING:

- a) Check with school to see if any financial help is available.
- b) No field trip forms are necessary this year per district. The school administration may still require field trip procedures be followed. This is not a field trip, but the coach is in charge of the team during the competition.
- c) If families travel and stay with the team, decide what time is team time and what is family time.
- d) Complete the behavior contract (one per team). No media form this year.
- e) Tell them: YOU ARE REPRESENTING GULF COAST REGION. BE ON YOUR BEST BEHAVIOR.

CHANGE WHATEVER THE TEAM WANTS TO CHANGE

- Props, backdrops, solution all can be changed or not as the <u>team</u> decides. Use score analysis given at coach meeting to help them understand scores as feedback.
- ✓ Do new paperwork: style, cost form, outside assistance, behavior contract, media release, required list, etc. Make copies.
- ✓ There is no more division 1A, 1B, Chipper, or Cookie, only divisions 1, 2, or 3.
- ✓ Our judges may have missed something. Clarifications can still be posted, but not requested.

SCHEDULES AND WORKER ASSIGNMENTS WILL COME VIA EMAIL FROM FREDA AND STATE

- \star Sent no later than two weeks before tournament, so look for it.
- ★ Freda will send at least three emails between now and state, so look for them AND ANSWER WHEN ASKED, PLEASE.

PICK UP REGIONAL FINALIST T-SHIRTS ON DESIGNATED DAYS

- Use website (www.gcodyssey.com) to place order for all team members and coaches.
- Complete form and give to person picking up shirts.
- Make sure the person picking up the shirts is aware if money is owed (extra shirts).
- Shirts are worn at state awards ceremony. We sit together as a region.
