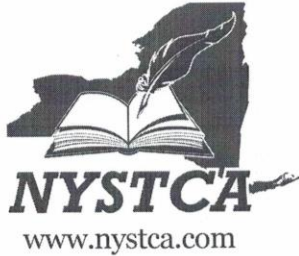
Resolved to sign agreement to spend highway funds with the Town/County.
