Beach Combing Cruise – Saturday, April 1, 2017 (2:00 PM – 5:00 PM)

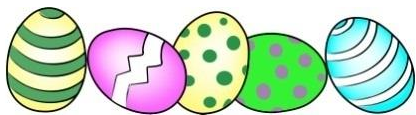

Wildlife of our World – Saturday, April 8, 2017 (11:00 AM – Noon)

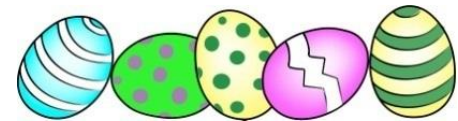

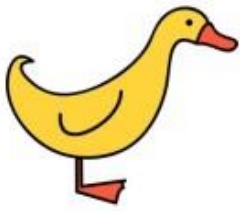
Twilight Egg Hunt – Ages 0-5 years (7:30 PM)

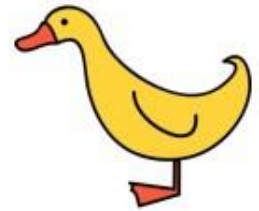
