(11) For we hear that some among you walk in idleness, not busy at work, but busybodies. (12) Now such persons we command and encourage in the Lord Jesus Christ to do their work quietly and to earn their own living. (13) As for you, brothers, do not grow weary in doing good. God's word admonishes us to work and support ourselves, not being lazy or inactive depending on the charity of others in order to survive. Colossians 3:17 MKJV And everything, whatever you do in word or deed, do all in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God and the Father by Him. We are to do everything, especially our work, in His name. This means ultimately we are doing it for him and not our employer. It does not matter it that employer is unfair, corrupt or cruel. Our work is done so that the LORD might be pleased and receive glory. This also entails thanking Him for providing this opportunity to work and not complaining.
