08	Early Junior Yearling Heifer - DOB November 1 - December 31, 2020

### Division 02 – Commercial Heifers

Commercial heifers must be 4 months of age or older. Sub-Classes will be determined by weight or hip height after check-in.

02	Medium Frame American Cross Commercial Heifer, determined by weight/hip height
03	Large Frame American Cross Commercial Heifer, determined by weight/hip height
04	Small Frame British Cross Commercial Heifer, determined by weight/hip height
05	Medium Frame British Cross Commercial Heifer, determined by weight/hip height
06	Large Frame British Cross Commercial Heifer, determined by weight/hip height
07	Small Frame Exotic Cross Commercial Heifer, determined by weight/hip height
08	Medium Frame Exotic Cross Commercial Heifer, determined by weight/hip height
09	Large Frame Exotic Cross Commercial Heifer, determined by weight/hip height
11	Commercial Cow Calf Pair

### 03 – Market Steers

Class	Class Description
01	Prospect Steer (Lt. Weight), determined by weight
02	Feeder Steer (Med. Weight), determined by weight
03	Market Steer (Heavy Weight), determined by weight

### 04 – Youth Beef Calf Project

Calves cannot weigh over 250 pounds as of May 1 of current year.

Class	Class Description
01	Heifer (for youth 13 and under)
02	Bull (for youth 13 and under)
03	Steer (for youth 13 and under)

### 05 – Beef Showmanship

Class	Class Description
01	Super Wee Junior - age 3 - 4 years, age as of date of show
02	Wee Junior - Age 5 - 8, age as of date of show
03	Junior - Age 9-13, age as of date of show
04	Senior - Age 14-19, age as of date of show
