- Contest must have a 2x3 headshot in the top left corner.

- Do not forget to use spell check. There is nothing worse than standing out as "that contestant" who spelled her state incorrectly.
- Always read what you have written to ensure it makes sense.
- When in doubt, keep it short and sweet. Sometimes, less is more!
