

19. Corts - Nine Patch Snowball pattern by Quiltin' Tia Quiltworks

This can be made using fat quarters or strips. The pattern has different sizes from crib to queen. I made the lap size which is really big 53" x 77". You decide which size you want to make and get the fabric accordingly. You can also work right out of your stash. Throw in all of the fabrics you love and it will be amazing. You'll need some yardage for background.

Neutral thread for piecing

Sewing machine in good working order with new needle

Basic sewing supplies

Rotary cutter, mat, quilter's rule

Precut before class: From background, cut the amount of 6 1/2" squares needed for the size you are making. You will have extra for the 2" border.

From the colors, cut 2 1/2" x 21" strips.
