4 - Little Free Library in the Garden – Thank you to Cassidy for teaming up with the industrial tech program at Hazelbrook Middle School to build the library. It was installed at the end of the last school year and we look forward to any and all enjoying in in the future.

5 - Teacher staffing for this year – all returning staff members this year.

- 3 kinder teachers
- $3-1^{st}$  grade teachers
- $4 2^{nd}$  grade teachers
- $3 3^{rd}$  grade teachers
- $3-4^{th}$  grade teachers
- 3 5<sup>th</sup> grade teachers

Best estimate for the number of students starting the year is between 484-490 students.

6 - We have a new program this year for Pre-school aged children. The class is not located at Tualatin Elementary but is overseen by Principal Kingery. The class is taught by a new teacher – Adam Harris. It is 2.5 hours each day either in the morning(8:30am-11:00am) or the afternoon(1:00pm-3:30pm). The have a few spots left. It is open to anyone, but priority will be given to children who live with the Tualatin Elementary boundary.

7 - We now have a one to one ratio of students to iPads in grades 2-5. They are not intended to replace instruction, only enhance instruction. If you have any questions please inquire with your student's teacher or afterward with Mr. Kingery.
