Lincoln Heights Industrial Zone Trash Receptacles Program still Pending on City Permits

The Board of Directors received notification in late January that they received the grant. The grant received was for \$5,000.00. The Board has purchased the trash cans, lids and identity plates. The ten trash receptacles will be placed throughout the district.

The Board is waiting to get the locations approved by the City Encroachment Department. The process may take until November. The City needs to review and approve each location. We are hoping that we will have them installed before then.

The City still has not approved the encroachment permits but we are getting closer. They asked for more information on the locations and detailed maps had to be designed for further review. We are hopeful that the new trash cans will be installed before Christmas.
