

Sgt. stated that was not injured.

On May 15, 2015 I received a memo from Sgt indicating that he had received a call from a regarding Ofc. She stated that she is his ex-wife and mother of his children and that she has been trying to reach him about support and child matters but he refuses to call her back. She left a cell phone number to call and Sgt felt that it should be handled above his level.

On May 19th I spoke with Ofc about the matter and told him that Ms. was trying to contact him and his refusal to call her back had caused her to contact us. Ofc felt that she was calling to retaliate against him and try to cause problems at his employment. I advised him that either way, he should try to resolve the matter amicably and either reach out to her in person or through their attorneys.

On May 21st I called Ms. but there was no answer so I left a message. I received a call back thereafter and we discussed the situation. I advised her that I had spoken with Ofc but added that I could not force him to call her or contact her but that if the matter escalated to a non support issue or a possible criminal or civil violation then we would get involved. Ms. stated that she understood and would wait for him to contact her.

On June 4th I received a message from Ms. and she stated that Ofc lid not call her back but instead had the local police respond to her house and ask her to refrain from calling his employment. She stated that at this point she would handle the matter through the court system and thanked us for our assistance.

During this interaction two females in the group that were intoxicated became very loud and aggressive and were going to be placed under arrest. One female was cooperating but the other, was refusing commands and putting up a struggle so the officers called out to ask for assistance. Ptlm. was dispatched as well as Sgt Upon their arrival they found that Cpl had a in custody and we were advised that Ptlm. was attempting to take another female into custody when she bit him on the leg breaking the skin. Ptlm. advised in custody and to be careful she had already bitten him. She was placed into a cruiser and then transported to the station by Ptlm. Once at the station was shown how to use the water in the cell to clean her eyes. Cpl. was charged with Municipal Disorderly Conduct, she was released at the station on a summons. Ptlm. advised Sgt that the bite had broken the skin and he was sent to the hospital for an evaluation. Sgt took photographs of Ptlm. left calf and these photographs were added to the arrest report. After Ptlm. was treated at this hospital he filled out an injury form and signed a After reviewing the details and circumstances relating to the actions of Ofc and Cpl response to this incident, it is evident that both officers used only the force that was reasonably necessary to diffuse the situation and protect themselves from physical harm. 




