- March: On Tuesday, March 28th, the Knights hosted the annual Kings Quad against Little Miami, Anderson, and Glen Este. The men and women dominated the scoreboard and both won the meet! 1st Place Finishes for the men include 4x800, 110m Hurdles J. Guckenberger, 1600m Run I. Onnen, 400m Dash K. Smith, 300m Hurdles J. Guckenberger, 800m Run I. Onnen, 200m Dash N. Williams, 3200m Run R. Winkler, 4x400m Men, 2000m Steeple J. Krynock, Discus T. Todd, Discus T. Brant, Hammer T. Todd, Hammer T. Brant, Long Jump N. Williams, Pole Vault I. Chunn.
- April Week 1: Hannah Rasmussen and the Knights Track & Field teams have continued to dominate the region at the start of spring! Ranked 5th in the city, the Knights gentlemen placed high in several events at the Northmont Invitational. Tops for the men were: 4x400 (3rd), High Jump-Y. Godfrey (3rd), and Long Jump N. Williams (3rd).
- April Week 2: The men and women had great days at the Coaches' Classic. The men

- came very close but finished 3rd, only 2 points behind St. Xavier and 16 points to La Salle. Top performers for the men: 4x800 relay won, Josh Guckenberger took it in the 300 hurdles, and Grant Coleman finished #1 in pole vault.
- April Week 3: At the Centerville Relays, the Knights Track & Field teams did well overall with the men finishing 8th of 16. The men took home 3rd in the 4x300 Hurdles (T. Diebel, J. Guckenberger, K. Smith, T. Meyer), as well as top performances in many other events.
- April Week 4: Huge congratulations go out to both teams as the girls team ranks #2 in the city and the boys team ranks #4 in the city. The Kings Senior Night Quad showed 1st place finishes in the following events: 110 M Hurdles (G. Coleman) 400 M (C. Owens), 300 M Hurdles (J. Guckenberger). The Kings Field Event festival had first place finishes in the 2000 M Steeple (J. Krynock), Triple Jump (Y. Godfrey), Hammer (D. Bird), Pole Vault (G. Coleman). The Loveland Invitational was rained out.
- May Week 1The men's and women's Track & Field teams competed in the Kings
 Invitational on Tuesday night at The Castle. The men ran, threw, and jumped extremely well
 with 1st place finishes in the 4x400 steeple and the 800 m, hammer throw and pole
 vault. The Kettering Fairmont and Dayton for the Roosevelt Invite was rained out with men
 being placed 7th upon it being called.
