





To re-create the factory edge, this instrument would need to be re-sharpened along the RED line.





DOUBLE GRACEY

The Double Gracey[™] is the latest innovation from American Eagle Instruments. Two instruments combined into one. This allows the operator to follow the Gracey technique, but with the economy of using universal curettes. The face of Double Graceys[™] are raised, thus creating two slightly sloped faces, approximately 110 degrees, measured from the terminal (lower) shank.

Benefits

- Allows the clinician to stay in one ergonomic position during scaling without shifting positions
- Allows clinician to keep lower shank parallel to tooth surface (axis), similar to traditional Gracey instrumentation
- Maneuver between mesial and distal surfaces without switching or flipping instruments
- Enables clinician to scale from light to heavy calculus
- Rounded toe provides safe access for subgingival scaling




XP INSTRUMENT MAINTENANCE

Do

- Lightly shave away heavy calculus with 4-6 strokes.
- Practice care as these are slimmer instruments
- Clean debris off instruments prior to sterilization
- Use cassettes for cleaning and storage
- Periodically test for sharpness which will avoid the potential for excessive pressure and/or breakage
- Use de-mineralized water
- Use Ph balanced cleaners
- Use AEI's ultrasonic cleaner solution
- Always rinse thoroughly prior to drying
- Always dry instruments thoroughly before storing

Avoid

- Use on margins, overhangs, amalgam, or composite
- Allow tips to touch while cleaning or storing
- Use Chlorine-based or Sodium-based solutions


