Act 26:19-23 (KJV)

"(19) Whereupon, O king Agrippa, I was not disobedient unto the heavenly vision: (20) But shewed first unto them of Damascus, and at Jerusalem, and throughout all the coasts of Judaea, and then to the Gentiles, that they should repent and turn to God, and do works meet for repentance. (21) For these causes the Jews caught me in the temple, and went about to kill me. (22) Having therefore obtained help of God, I continue unto this day, witnessing both to small and great, saying none other things than those which the prophets and Moses did say should come: (23) That Christ should suffer, and that he should be the first that should rise from the dead, and should shew light unto the people, and to the Gentiles."

Prayer Warrior request cards are located on the back bookshelf next to the water fountain. Please fill out a card with the information listed below and then return it to the box clearly marked, "**Prayer Warriors**"

On the card:

- 1. Your name (so we can pray for you directly and we know who to give another card to)
- 2. Any special requests for yourself that you would like to have prayed about (spiritual, physical, work, family, etc.,);
- 3. Any special requests for someone else and their needs;
- 4. Any special requests for someone whom you may be carrying a burden for:
- 5. Any other requests that you would like to have prayed about or are seeking answering on.
- 6. There is not a limit on how many you can list (use front and back of card if needed)
