## General Information and Contest Guidelines

- Single entry or teams welcome, team max, five people. Set up location will be on a first come basis.
- Contestants must furnish own ingredients, equipment, serving utensils and power cords.
- Use a favorite recipe, with or without meat, with or without beans. Meat may be beef, bison, pork, lamb, chicken, turkey or venison. Veggie (meatless chili) is also allowed. Beans are encouraged but not mandatory.
- Ingredients may be cut, shredded or ground to any size.
- Please have a list of the ingredients used for allergy purposes. If peanuts or peanut oil or any nuts are used, please display a warning sign.
- Canned, store bought chili or mixes may NOT be used.
- Each contestant must provide one gallon of chili.
- Contestants must bring own condiments (such as cheese, sour cream, onions, etc.)
- Chili is to be brought "ready to eat". All chili must be at serving temperature when the contest begins and kept warm in a crock pot during contest hours.
- Contestants must come up with a name for the chili and have it displayed during the contest.
- Red Tomato Farm \& Inn will provide spoons, cups and napkins for serving samples to the general public.
- Two contestant will be awarded a prize for the "Popular Vote Chili" and "CALC Choice".
