Georgia Tax Credit Scholarship Program

Through the Georgia Tax Credit Scholarship Program, you can choose to redirect a portion of your Georgia state income tax dollars to Springmont to support financial aid for deserving students.

So how does the program work? The State of Georgia sets aside \$58 million annually in tax credits for individuals and corporations that donate funds to a Student Scholarship Organization (SSO). Through this program, Georgia taxpayers can redirect up to \$1,000 if filing individually or up to \$2,500 if filing jointly to an independent school of their choosing in Georgia. Georgia C-Corporations can contribute up to 75% of their corporate tax liability. Participants receive a dollar-for-dollar credit on their state income taxes.

The redirected funds are sent to Springmont to provide financial assistance to qualified incoming applicants to the school.
