### **Shelby County Amateur Radio Emergency Services Net Procedures**

**(S.C.A.R.E.S.) - Every Sunday evening at 7PM  
on 146.835 - shift**

**Tone in 835 to set off papers and make announcement of net  
starting 5 minutes before**

**“Good evening, this is the time and the frequency for the Shelby County Amateur Radio Emergency Services Net. This net meets every Sunday evening at 7pm on the frequency of 146.835. This net meets for the purposes of handling traffic and testing equipment, plus training for working within a controlled net. This is a controlled net. Stations wishing to break the net, please use your all sign. Net control is (Name), (Call) located in (Location). Please check in with your call phonetically, give your name and location, whether you have any traffic, plus if you are on commercial or emergency power. If you are using a Yaesu Fusion radio, please be sure you are transmitting only in FM mode.”**

**First off, is there any emergency or priority traffic? Please call (Call Sign)**

**(Pause) (If there is any traffic, ask if anyone will take the traffic. If it is Emergency or Priority traffic, the traffic needs to be taken immediately.)**

**We will now take check-ins from low power or hand held stations. Please call (Call Sign).**

**(Pause) -----acknowledge stations that check in**

**We will now take check-ins from Mobile Stations. Please call (Call Sign)**

**(Pause) -----acknowledge stations that check in**

**We will now take check-ins from all stations, fixed or otherwise. Please call (Call Sign)**

**(Pause) -----acknowledge stations that check in.**

**(After check-ins, ask for any comments)**

**Are there any announcements or further comments for the good of the net? If so please call now. (Pause for comments or queries)**

**This will be the last call for any check-ins, comments or queries, please call now**

**Thanks to all stations that checked in. We had (#) check-ins, counting myself. This concludes this session of the Shelby County Amateur Radio Emergency Services Net. Everyone have a good evening. This is (Call Sign) returning the frequency to normal amateur use.**
