#### CATALINA RECAP:

The 2017 trip to Catalina was a success, I know that I loved seeing the countless photos of the kids in action! This year was Copper Ridge's final visit to Cherry Cove! Don't worry, future trips will be to a new location on the island where we will continue to have access to the same programs, as well as similar accommodations. We do not yet know the exact location, but all of that will be figured out before next years trip!

There was not much sleeping taking place on the buses on the way to California, as excitement was running high! They had a fantastic breakfast at the Anaheim Hilton, and were then on their way to Long Beach pier. This year's ferry crossing to the island was the calmest and smoothest journey that we've ever had! The water was quite calm, and the weather was absolutely beautiful. ### NJHS INFO FOR FUTURE 8TH GRADERS:

The National Junior Honor Society (NJHS) is an international student organization that consists of chapters in middle schools. The academic eligibility for NJHS is a 3.85 GPA during EACH of the 4 quarters of 7th grade. This equates to either straight A's, or all A's with one (ONLY one) B each quarter.

GPA is NOT CUMULATIVE, so if a student gets straight A's during quarter 1, but 2 B's during quarter 2, they are not academically eligible because their 2nd quarter GPA will be below 3.85.

Students who are academically eligible at the end of 7th grade will receive an application packet from Mrs. Boepple. Students must complete the packet, and return by the submission deadline (dates to be determined). Application packets are reviewed by the faculty committee with regard to leadership, citizenship, etc. Students are then notified of acceptance or non-acceptance by letter within the first week or so after school lets out for the summer.
