### 3. Communications

Minutes from the State Association of Fire Districts, contains information regarding the State – Bill A1690 – that establishes the procedures for board of fire commissioners to move the annual fire district elections to November, eliminates certain fire district budget referenda and eliminates certain fire district capitol purchase referenda. This bill passed the full assembly on May  $22^{nd}$  and the next step is consideration by the full Senate. Edward Paul was aware of this bill and could further clarify its intent. At this time there no actions that are being taken, however further details will be brought up as they are revealed.

### 6. Old Business

The Board of Fire Commissioners, District 4 and the Fire Company completed researching a policy and program for medical physical program for all Fire Company members. The Fire Company Chief was sent a pricing schedule. We are waiting for the Chief to decide on how he wants to proceed.

The semiannual generator maintenance will take place next week on August 28<sup>th</sup>. Andrew Bellone Jr. will be at the Fire Department to allow the technician access.

The mutual aid agreement was signed and scanned. The original was sent to the Gloucester County OEM.

The 2017 KME Rescue truck is scheduled to be completed and delivered to us on this coming Thursday. As soon as the truck is completed, the Chief will go over it and create the "punch list" if needed. Once the Chief and the truck committee are satisfied that the truck is completed, the Board will sign the certificate of origin and complete the transfer of ownership paperwork.

Scott Graiff proposal to the Board that the "old rescue truck (old 43-58)" be repurposed as a new utility truck had been completed. It was renumbered as 43-57.

As part of the above motion, the old utility truck "old 43-57" was converted to the Chiefs command vehicle and renumbered as 43-50. The current Chiefs vehicle was repurposed as the Deputy Chiefs command vehicle. The current Deputy Chiefs command vehicle has been removed from service as it is not cost effective to repair. All vehicles have had their individual numbering and lettering changed to reflect their new operational roles.

Andrew Bellone Jr. will be contacting the JIF insurance people to get clarification of the proposed changes and conversion from our current insurance company to JIF. This will be discussed and the next meeting. Michael Thomas from Glenn Insurance has notified the Board that he would like to attend the next Board meeting to review the JIF coverages and policies.



### 7. New Business

Justin Garofalo – junior application for membership was received. No background check done as this is a junior member. The Chief has the signed permission from the parents of the applicant. The Board signed the application and it will be given to the Chief for further processing.

Edward Paul was present to review the Audit Report for 2016. There were questions that were asked regarding a few line items on the audit. Ed Paul was able to answer these questions and eliminate the confusion.

There is still as \$2,500.00 grant that was received that was not applied. The Board believes that the funds were for the replacement SCBA's, or for the purchase of the SCBA fit testing machine. The Board forwarded the funds in advance of the grant to pay for the SCBA's. The grant should have been applied to that expenditure. Thomas Bellone Sr. will go through the records to determine if this is correct.

There were 2 small amounts of money that will be moved to clear completed projects. One amount from the capital improvement project that was completed in the amount of \$16.05 and one amount in the amount of \$2.36 from debt service. These amounts will be transferred to the general fund balance. Since the projects are closed, there is no need to leave these funds on those line items.

A resolution will need to be made at the end of the year to transfer these 2 amounts.

The audit did not reveal any anomalies or errors.

The Audit report for 2016 was accepted and the resolution was read aloud. The Board signed the resolution and the 2016 audit is complete. The resolution will be scanned and a copy will be posted on the website for public review.

Edward Paul will forward an editable (MS Word or Excel) copy of the Audit Report so that it can be submitted to the Courier Post for public notice. Our current copy is in .pdf format.

### 8. Public Comments continued

President of the Fire Department:

Mark Mastro and members of the Finance committee were present to discuss the renewal of the lease agreement. This proposal if approved would commence January 2018.

The Fire Company finance committee is requesting that the rent be increased from \$1,200.00 to \$3,875.00 per month, however their proposal does not break down the increase. The finance committee stated that parts of the increase would include that the Fire Department take over the paying of the gas, electric, cellular phone and other utility bills. The proposal also included that the Fire Department take over the building maintenance. A discussion was had regarding the proposal and it was agreed that certain aspects of their proposal were detrimental to the fire department should there be a catastrophic incident.

The finance committee did not have an actual lease agreement to present.

The Board reminded the finance committee that the building maintenance issue was discussed last year and that the financial breakdown was quite prohibitive for the fire company to be responsible for.

The finance committee will re-review the proposal and resubmit a new proposal with an actual lease agreement to the Board at our next meeting. The Board will review the lease proposal and will negotiate the actual rent increase when we determine the budget for 2018.

### 9. Adjournment

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40A:5-4 requires the governing body of every local unit to have made an annual audit of its books, accounts, and financial transactions; and

WHEREAS, the Annual Report of Audit for the year ending December 31, 2016 has been filed by a Registered Municipal Accountant with the Secretary as per the requirements of N.J.S.A. 40A:5-6, and a copy has been received by each member of the governing body; and

WHEREAS, the Local Finance Board of the State of New Jersey is authorized to prescribe reports pertaining to the local fiscal affairs as per R.S. 52:27BB-34; and

WHEREAS, the Local Finance Board has promulgated a regulation requiring that the governing body of each fire district shall by resolution certify to the Local Finance Board of the State of New Jersey that all members of the governing body has reviewed, as a minimum, the sections of the Annual Audit entitled:

as evidenced by the group affidavit form of the governing body; and

WHEREAS, such resolution of certification shall be adopted by the governing body no later than forty-five days after receipt of the Annual Audit, as per the regulations of the Local Finance Board; and

WHEREAS, all members of the governing body have received and have familiarized themselves with, at least, the minimum requirements of the Local Finance Board of the State of New Jersey, as stated aforesaid and have subscribed to the affidavit, as provided by the Local Finance Board; and

WHEREAS, failure to comply with the promulgations of the Local Finance Board of the State of New Jersey may subject the members of the governing body to the penalty provisions of R.S. 52:27BB-52 - to wit:

R.S. 52:27BB-52 - "A local officer or member of a local governing body who, after a date fixed for compliance, fails or refuses to obey an order of the Director (Director of Local Government Services), under the provisions of this Article, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and, upon conviction, may be fined not more than one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00) or imprisoned for not more than one year, or both, in addition shall forfeit his office."
