DESCRIPTION: The 61 Polar was a grade above the Grizzly, and a step below the Kodiak. Bubinga riser. Bow has no delamination; no cracks; limbs are straight. No screw holes; Overlays and tips are in great condition. No chips, dings or cracks. No crazing or stress cracks; a few light repaired superficial stress lines. A few minor scratches and nicks here and there. Decal is in poor-fair condition. There was considerable "yellowing" and wear and tear on the limbs. They were re-stained with white India ink, except for the decals. They look OK but not great. Overall, this is still a nice bow in very good condition for a 60 year old.

Note: I put this bow to a stress test (held at full draw for 18 hours) to see if the old glues would hold and if any stress lines would emerge. Bow passed the test.
