Broomfield Spellbinders has a New Leader

Julie will have the support of the Steering Committee who share responsibility for fiscal oversight and record-keeping, as well as relations with schools and the Spellbinders organization; meeting planning; and recruitment and training of new members (see below).

You Can Become A Volunteer Storyteller

As soon as Covid guidelines allowed it, a few Broomfield Spellbinders were able to return to in-person classroom storytelling where interaction with the students brightened our lives and theirs. We are confident that more schools will welcome us back for the 2022-23 school year, so we have scheduled training for new volunteer storytellers for September 20, 23, 26, and 29 at Brunner Farmhouse. Each class will be for three hours, starting at 1 p.m. Participation in all four classes is required for certification, but alternate arrangements are usually possible if a participant must miss just one class. The fee is \$50 which covers the cost of training materials and nametags for the new tellers. A brief interview and background check must be completed before the training starts. 


Museo's Traveling Exhibition Program

2022 Broomfield Days Poster Contest

Each year for decades, the Broomfield Days Poster Contest puts out a call for artistic submissions that reflect the community spirit of Broomfield Days. Local leaders and residents select the 1st and 2nd place winners. The winning artists are announced at BCAH's Summer Sunday Fest on August 14 and receive a monetary award (\$100 for 1st place and \$50 for 2nd place). The 1st place winning artist also has their artwork printed as the official poster for that year. Posters are archival quality, limited edition, and signed by the artist. Only 50 posters are printed each year. For those artists under 16 years of age, BCAH is announcing a Junior Award category with an award and ribbon. Proceeds from poster sales and entry fees are applied to the following year's awards and printing costs.



Will this year's winner be you? Paintings, drawings, photographs, digital art, and mixed media are accepted; must be 16"x20". Artists of all ages are encouraged to submit up to three entries. Each entry is \$10-15. Entry forms and fees must be received by July 1. Artwork must be delivered to the Brunner Farmhouse on July 25.
