

ORDINANCE NO. 31

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE USE OF HIGHWAYS AND STREETS WITHIN THE VILLAGE OF NEW MUNICH, MINNESOTA AND IMPOSING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF

The Council of the village of New Munich, Minnesota do ordain as follows:

Section 1. Careless Driving: No person shall operate or halt any vehicle upon a street or highway within the Village of New Munich, Minnesota, carelessly or heedlessly in disregard of the rights or safety of others or in a manner so as to endanger or be ~~likely~~ likely to endanger any person or property.

Section 2. Speed Regulations: No person driving a vehicle within the village of New Munich, shall drive the same at a speed ~~greater~~ greater than is reasonable and prudent under the conditions and having regard to the actual and potential hazards then existing. In every event speed shall be so restricted as may be necessary in order to avoid colliding with any person, vehicle or other conveyance on or entering the highway of street in compliance with legal requirements and the duty of all persons to use due care, but in any case not to exceed a speed of 30 miles per hour.

Section 3. Driving under the influence of liquor: No person shall drive or operate any vehicle on any street or highway within the village while under the influence of liquor and no person shall consume liquor while an occupant of a vehicle upon any street or highway in the village.

Section 4. Driving bicycles: No person shall operate a bicycle on the sidewalks of said village of New Munich at any time.

~~Section 5~~ Every vehicle parked upon any street with a curb shall be parked parallel to the curb and with the right hand wheels of such vehicle within 12 inches of the curb, except such vehicles as shall park upon the ~~west side of Main Street~~ shall park diagonally in a southwesterly direction, touching the curb and in all cases within spaces marked by Chief of Police.

Section 6. Penalty: Any person convicted of violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be punished by a fine of not to exceed ~~\$100.00~~ \$100.00 or by imprisonment in County Jail for a period of not to exceed 90 days, but if a minimum fine of imprisonment is prescribed by the state highway traffic act for an offense, such penalty shall ~~apply~~ apply to a person convicted of the same offense under this ordinance.

Ordinance No. 31

An Ordinance Regulating the use of Highways and streets within the Village of New Munich, Minnesota and imposing Penalties for the violation thereof.

Amund Worms a member of said Council offered Ordinance No. 31 and moved its adoption. This motion was second by John Le Claire a member of said Council and put to vote, all members of said Council voted in favor of said motion for its adoption. The Council of the Village of New Munich do, obtain as follows:

Section 1. Careless Driving: No person shall operate or halt any vehicle upon a street or highway within the village of New Munich, Minnesota, carelessly or heedlessly in disregard of the rights or safety of others or in a manner so as to endanger or be to endanger any person or property.

Section 2. Speed Regulations: No person driving in the village of New Munich, shall drive the vehicle the same at a speed greater than is reasonable and prudent under the conditions and having regard to the actual and potential hazards then existing. In every event speed shall be so restricted as may be necessary in order to avoid colliding with any person, vehicle or other conveyance or entering the highway or street in compliance with legal requirements and the duty of all persons to use due care, but in any case not to exceed a speed of 30 miles per hour.

Section 3. Driving under the influence of liquor: No person shall drive or operate any vehicle on any street or highway within the village while under the influence of liquor and no person shall consume liquor while an occupant of a vehicle upon any street or highway in the Village:

Section 4. Driving bicycles: No person shall operate a bicycle on the sidewalks of said village of New Munich at any time.

Section 5. Every vehicle parked upon any street with a curb shall be parked parallel to the curb and with the right hand wheels of such vehicle within inches

of the curb, except such vehicles as shall park by the West side of Main Street shall park diagonally in a south westerly direction, touching the curb right front tire, and in all cases within sections 6. Penalty: Any Person convicted of

violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be

penalized therefor. This ordinance shall not be in force until the 1st day of June, 1948.

not to exceed 90 days, but if a maximum of a fine of imprisonment is prescribed by the state highway traffic act for an offense, such penalty shall apply to a person convicted of the same offense under this ordinance.
