- **Finish:** Between yellow flag on Race Committee boat and Region 2 Baltimore Harbor and Patapsco River Standard Racing Mark "K" (G"23"). Course may be shortened at any designated course mark. Boats not finishing are requested to notify Race Committee boat on VHF Channel 72.

Time Limit: 4 hours.

- **Protests:** Protester should immediately notify Race Committee boat upon finishing. Written protest forms must be postmarked by Tuesday 19 July 2016 to the contact listed above. Protester and protested will be notified of the time and place of the protest hearing.
