

Country Yarns

Make one ... (M1R)= make one right

pick up the bar between the last stitch just knit and the next stitch to be knit- bring the left hand needle from back to front, then knit into the front of this stitch.

Make One Left: M1L pick up the bar between the stitch you knit and the one you're about to knit, bringing the needle from front to back. Then knit into the back of the stitch.

Make one ... (M1R)= make one right

pick up the bar between the last stitch just knit and the next stitch to be knit- bring the left hand needle from back to front, then knit into the front of this stitch.

Picot bind off... please cast on 40 stitches, knit one row purl one row for 8 rows, cast on two stitches and bind off four stitches for each point. No matter how many stitches you cast on, always bind off twice as many stitches for each point.

To continue the picot bind off, slip that one stitch that's now on the right hand needle back onto the left hand needle as if to purl. Cast on the same number of stitches you did at the beginning and then bind off the same number of stitches again.

Continue in this manner until you have worked all the way across the row. When you're down to just one stitch on the right hand needle, cut the yarn and pull it through the final loop as usual. Country Yarns uses this Bind Off on Shawls, Cowls, etc... to give a decorative edge.

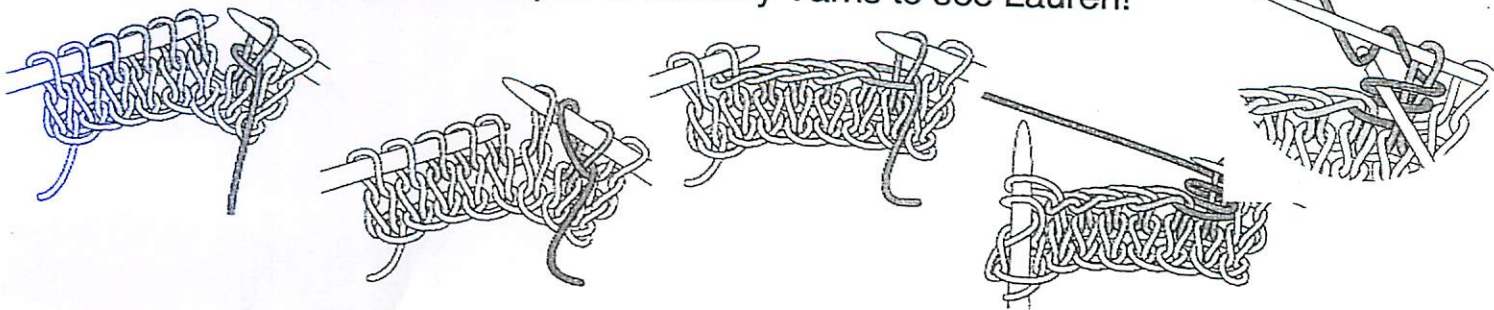
Tulip buttonhole...

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Cast on 10 sts, work 4 rows in st. st, Next knit one, bring yarn to front, slip next st to RH ndl as to purl, bring yarn to back, slip st back to LH ndl, bring yarn to front, slip next st to RH ndl as to purl, With LH ndl snag loop you just made at base of st on RH ndl and place it on Tip of RH ndl, without twisting it, now slip next st from left ndl to right ndl.

There are now 4sts on RH ndl, With tip of Left ndl draw the snagged stitch and bring it over the st at tip, of RH ndl, there are now 3 sts on RH ndl. *slip st from LH ndl to RH ndl, now bind off one, repeat from * 3 more times, place st at tip of RH ndl back to LH ndl, there 2 sts on RH ndl and 4sts on LH ndl.

Now slip st on RH ndl to LH ndl, bring your yarn to the back, bring st back to RH ndl, bring yarn to front, put st back to LH ndl, bring yarn to back, slip st back to RH ndl, bring yarn to front, slip st to LH ndl, bring yarn to back, now slip st back to RH ndl, (two wraps made) Now cast on upper stitches, with crochet hook insert upwards onto loop just made around base of st on RH ndl, *yarn over needle, now catch yo with crochet hook, and bring thru the st on hook, 1st cast on, repeat from * 3 more times, 6 sts on RH ndl, 1st on crochet hook, bring yarn to front, place stitch on crochet hook on RH ndl, 7 sts on RH ndl, Take next st on LH ndl and place on RH ndl, slip second st on RH ndl over St at tip, bring yarn to back knit to end.
