6. _____ The Board adjusts the boundaries (executive limitations) of the administrator as needed.
7. _____ The Board members do not act for the board outside of board meetings.
8. _____ The Board members point stakeholders with concerns to the leader.
9. _____ The Board makes policy decisions based the mission and board outcomes.
10. _____ The Board speaks with one voice or not at all.
11. _____ The Board encourages a strategic direction for the ministry.
12. _____ The Board approves broad, leader-provided policy, always asking why it is needed.
13. _____ The Board monitors the progress of the ministry towards its outcomes.
