- New changes were highlighted which included 3 additional application questions recommended by NPC Foundation, and the addition of the good standing requirement for alumnae continuing education scholarships. Additional points have been added for community service activities. Information provided in both the application and reference letters are scored.

#### **Unfinished Business**

- ◆ Commitment to Excellence
  - ◆ Committee has met several times, presented to Council, and reviewed guidelines from NPC to provide clear expectations by members and a clear process.
  - Commitment to Excellence is proposed to be placed in standing rules and the removal of officers section in bylaws, with amendment to this standing rules in a similar procedure to bylaw amendments.
  - ◆ A number of suggestions were made by Council members back to the committee and revisions will be emailed and presented at next meeting. Additional suggestions should be submitted by October 23rd.
- ◆ Phoenix Panhellenic Centennial Scholarship Fund, an endowment with NPC Foundation
  - $\bullet$  At September meeting, Sandra Gocke A $\Phi$  proposed Phoenix Panhellenic move \$10,000 from general savings into the endowment. The reasoning is that the endowment pays out higher interest rates, helps Panhellenic to reach the targeted goal, and still keeps plenty of funds available in general savings for a rainy day.
  - \* Sara Mayer AΦ suggested there be a process set in place and/or limits set on annual transfer of funds. Niki Sams ΦM agreed and requested a process be in place before transferring additional funds.

- Patricia Reed  $A\Xi\Delta$  moved the \$10,000 be transferred at this time to the Phoenix Panhellenic Centennial Scholarship Fund. Kim OBrien seconded the motion.
  - ◆ Additional discussion clarified that the \$5,000 approved in September had been already sent to NPC Foundation and was not included in the proposed \$10,000.
  - Sandra Gocke AΦ reminded Council members to look at the actual expenses and pointed out that there would still be more than funds for 2 years expenses remaining in general savings.
  - + Holly Hatch AXΩ asked Council, why would you not treat Panhellenic funds like your own and not invest for a better return.
  - Sara Mayer  $A\Phi$  called the question. The motion passed with one abstention.
