DIRECTORS NEWS

The Board has approved a minor change to our constitution, clarifying our mission statement in support our 501(c)(3) non-profit status. We would like to add Provisions E and F to the Constitution, Article II, objects as follows:


E. Further: IWLA York Chapter No. 67 is organized exclusively for charitable, educational, and scientific purposes under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

F. Further: Upon the dissolution of IWLA York Chapter No. 67, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to a state or local government, for a public purpose."

This must be approved by a 2/3 vote of the voting members present at the July election.

FUNSHOOT Our FunShoots have morphed into a falling steel type shoot.

They are designed for almost any shooter, from the novice to the experienced multigunner. Primary guns are pistols and pistol caliber carbines. Yes, .22's are allowed! This is a casual, freeform shoot requiring little movement, timers or scoring. Our primary mission is to provide a venue to introduce yourself, your friends and kids to shooting. We are very family friendly! We shoot every 4th Sunday of the Month. FIND OUT MORE

3-GUN Three gun action matches are exciting and fast-paced, and require competitors to be extremely familiar with rules and procedures before participating in matches. If you've never seen a real 3 gun match we invite you to come see one (bring eye and ear protection) and introduce yourself. We'll be happy to answer questions and get you pointed in the right direction. We follow the Midatlantic 3 gun rules.

Pre-registration is mandatory for all York 3-Gun action matches. Sign-up for the 3-Gun at York is announced on the blogspot about 5 days before each match FIND OUT MORE and is required.

USPSA is a fast-paced, action-packed sport based on accuracy, power and speed. Shooters compete in one of eight divisions using either a pistol, revolver or pistol caliber carbine (PCC). Beginners are welcome, but you must be able to safely draw a handgun, perform reloads and navigate our courses of fire. If you have never shot an action shooting match (USPSA, IDPA, 3-gun, etc.) before you will be required to attend a pre-match safety briefing prior to your first match. USPSA has an extensive set of safety rules; we highly recommend reviewing them before your first match. Registration for each match will be via Practiscore at https://practiscore.com/clubs/york_uspsa and will open a week before the match.

FALLING STEEL Falling Steel matches are very similar to fun shoots with two key differences. These are timed, and no rimfires are allowed. There may be between 4 and 6 stages each comprised of 25-35 pieces of steel anywhere from 10 to 25 yards away. We allow shooters to use one centerfire firearm, and it may be a pistol or pistol caliber carbine, and occasionally we allow shotguns. You may shoot as many rounds as FIND OUT MORE required. No experience is necessary, but pre-registration is required.

22 RIMFIRE 22 Rimfire precision matches are meant to mimic their big brother, the Centerfire Long Range Precision match. The RPM consists of 6-8 stages and usually 60-100 rounds required to shoot the match. We incorporate different shooting positions and props in order to make a challenging course of fire that requires efficiently getting into position and engaging targets anywhere from 5-200 yards within 30-90 seconds depending on the stage requirements. EGG SHOOTS Egg Shoots are a 22lr only shooting sport that is not terribly complicated, but still challenging. The targets are typically 40 steel targets shaped like eggs and the size of an actual chicken egg. We shoot them in banks of 10 eggs at 10, 15, 20 and 25 yards with rifles, and/or 7,9,11,and 13 yards with pistols. There is no real time limit, but they are shot standing with no support, and you may only use one round per egg. No experience is necessary, but pre-registration is required. FIND OUT MORE

RIFLE We offer a 100 yard and a 200 yard Rifle Range as well as one 50 yard pit and a short range pistol area.
