Holstein steers were up slightly and we didn't have any groups of good mixed steers to test the market. Butcher cows were steady to slightly lower. The Dairy cattle prices were unchanged for the most part but did also show a bit more activity. It's been a bit of a break on the horse sale side of things but things are starting to fire up again as we're preparing for the Midwinter Horse Pull and the first Driving Horse Auction in 2018. The Draft Consignments are steadily coming in and we are excited for a busy Spring. See you at TLA!
