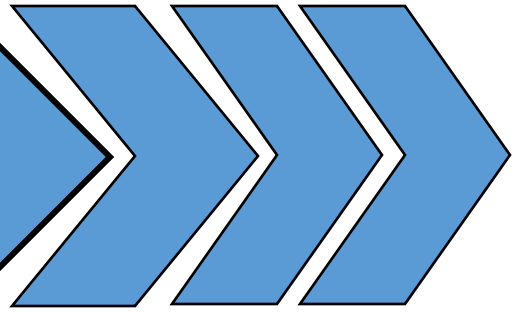

Ohio Age-Appropriate Transition Assessment Library

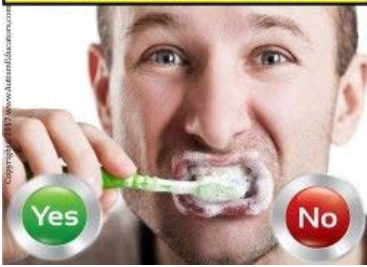
This website was designed to be a library of vetted age-appropriate transition resources for educators working with transition-aged youth in Ohio schools.

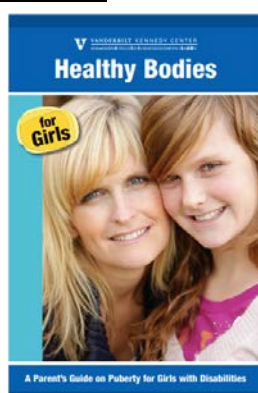
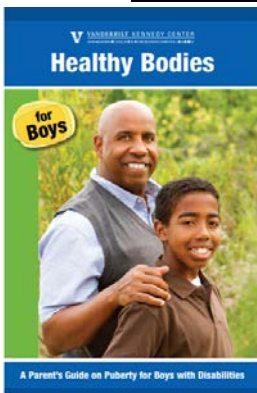
