
GRIEF SHARE gives help & encouragement after the death of a spouse, child, family member or friend. There will be weekly topics, videos, discussion and journaling and personal study.

SERMON TITLE: **HOPELESSNESS TO HOPE** – Jesus reaches out to the Disciples

(even Thomas)

SERMON TEXT: Luke 24:36-49 John 20:19-29

Crippling and overwhelming disappointment robs us of hope and challenges our sensibilities of what is real. HOPELESSNESS plagues our world and our lives as it did for the disciples in the $1^{\rm st}$ century, especially after ALL the disciple's HOPES AND EXPECTATIONS WERE SHATTERED with the traumatic realities of the crucifixion of Jesus on Good Friday.

And then, before all the trauma had even settled, Jesus appears to the disciples and asks them to join him in a new reality that offers boundless HOPE and POSSIBILITY.

How are they to move from HOPELESSNESS TO HOPE and from DISBELIEF TO BELIEF?

Sermon Outline:

- 1. Traumatic, life-changing disappointments open our lives to the darkness of HOPELESSNESS & DESPAIR WE ARE OVERWHELMED BY THE CIRCUMSTANCES OF LIFE
- 2. BUT THEN JESUS REVEALS HIMSELF TO US, ENCOURAGES US, AND REMINDS US, "PEACE BE WITH YOU!"
- 3. OVER A MEAL THE SACRAMENT --- THE PASCHAL MYSTERY
 - * OUR MINDS,
 - * OUR LIVES.
 - * OUR VERY SOULS Are OPENED TO JESUS
 - + HIS PEACE
 - + HIS PRESENCE
 - + HIS PROMISE
 - + HIS DIRECTION BE MY WITNESSES
- 4. AS WE REALIZE THE TRUE PRESENCE OF JESUS OUR HOPELESSNESS MOVES TO HOPE. OUR LIVES ARE: RESET, RENEWED and RESTORED.

EVEN THE LIFE AND SOUL OF THOMAS --- OF ALL DOUBTERS ... THAT ARE WILLING TO MEET JESUS WHEN HE COMES THEIR LIVES ARE CHANGED AND RENEWED AND OUR HOPELESSNESS IS CHANGED TO HOPE!!!!

BOTTOM-LINE: WHEN JESUS REVEALS HIMSELF ... AND IF WE CHOOSE TO RECOGNIZE AND REALIZE HIM ... HE OPENS THE DOOR TO **HIS DIVINE PEACE & PRESENCE**

OPENED HEARTS, MINDS, AND SOULS and POWER OF THE SACRAMENT --i.e THE VERY PRESENCE OF JESUS

ALLOWING GOD TO OPEN OUR SENSES BRINGS US DIVINE PEACE, POWER, PROMISE & PRESENCE THAT TURNS HOPELESSNESS INTO HOPE!!!!! AND PREPARES US FOR ALL THAT GOD INTENDS FOR US IN MISSION AND MEANING!!!!

WHEN JESUS COMES TO US ... WHEN JESUS REVEALS HIMSELF ... JESUS BLESSES --- "PEACE BE WITH YOU"

JESUS BREATHES HIS HOLY SPIRIT UPON YOU

JESUS BESTOWS UPON YOU "A CHILD OF GOD"

WILL YOU RECEIVE JESUS? WILL YOU BE OPEN? WILL YOU BELIEVE?

LUKE 24:36-49 & John 20:19-29

LUKE 24:36-49

- ³⁶ While they were still talking about this, Jesus himself stood among them and said to them, "**PEACE BE WITH YOU.**"
- ³⁷ They were startled and frightened, *thinking they saw* a ghost. ³⁸ *He said to them*, "Why are you troubled, and why do doubts rise in your minds? ³⁹ *Look at my hands* and my feet. It is I myself! Touch me and see; a ghost does not have flesh and bones, as you see I have."
- ⁴⁰ When he had said this, he *showed them* his hands and feet. ⁴¹ And while they still did not believe it because of joy and amazement, he asked them, "Do you have anything here to eat?" ⁴² They gave him a piece of broiled fish, ⁴³ and **he took it and ate it in their presence**.
- ⁴⁴ **He said to them**, "This is what I told you while I was still with you: Everything must be fulfilled that is written about me in the Law of Moses, the Prophets and the Psalms."
- ⁴⁵ **Then he opened their minds so they could understand the Scriptures.** ⁴⁶ He told them, "This is what is written: The Messiah will suffer and rise from the dead on the third day, ⁴⁷ and repentance for the forgiveness of sins will be preached in his name to all nations, beginning at Jerusalem. ⁴⁸ You are witnesses of these things. ⁴⁹ **I am going to send you what my Father has promised**; but stay in the city until you have been clothed with power from on high."

JOHN 20:19-29

On the evening of that first day of the week, when the disciples were together, with **the doors locked for fear** of the Jewish leaders, Jesus came and stood among them and said, "**PEACE BE WITH YOU!**" ²⁰ After he said this, he showed them his hands and side. The disciples were overjoyed when they saw the Lord.

²¹ Again Jesus said, **"PEACE BE WITH YOU!** As the Father has sent me, I am sending you." ²² And with that he breathed on them and said, **"Receive the Holy Spirit.** ²³ If you forgive anyone's sins, their sins are forgiven; if you do not forgive them, they are not forgiven."

²⁴ Now Thomas (also known as Didymus), one of the Twelve, was not with the disciples when Jesus came. ²⁵ So the other disciples told him, "We have seen the Lord!"

But he said to them, "Unless I see the nail marks in his hands and put my finger where the nails were, and put my hand into his side, I will not believe."

²⁶ A week later his disciples were in the house again, and Thomas was with them. Though the doors were locked, Jesus came and stood among them and said, "Peace be with you!" ²⁷ Then he said to Thomas, "Put your finger here; see my hands. Reach out your hand and put it into my side. Stop doubting and believe."

²⁸ Thomas said to him, "MY LORD AND MY GOD!"

²⁹ Then Jesus told him, "Because you have seen me, you have believed; blessed are those who have not seen and yet have believed."
