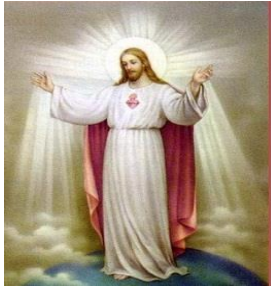

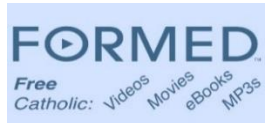


Decorate St. Joseph's Altar:

Spirituality Corner *by Virginia Fraguio, OCDS*

St. Joseph: Father of Fathers

The Holy Land has a beautiful unassuming church of St. Joseph very close to the much larger Church of the Annunciation in Nazareth. I visited it barely a year after my father Carlos passed away. There is a lovely stained-glass window of St. Joseph on his deathbed being cared for by Jesus and Mary. I thought I could see my own dad as he peacefully passed away like St. Joseph, under the gaze of Jesus and Mary. It reminded me of so many good fathers everywhere who like Joseph the foster father of Jesus and my dad, left an indelible mark on those they cared for, for which we are so eternally grateful today. Fr. Don Calloway, MIC writes in his book *Consecration to St. Joseph*: “The loving relationship between a spiritual father and child endures forever. In other words, Jesus continues to be the Son of Joseph in heaven. What is valid for Jesus is valid for us. St. Joseph is forever our spiritual father. As he took care of Jesus while on earth, St. Joseph will take care of you on your earthly pilgrimage. St. Joseph is your loving provider, educator, and protector.”

We all know that the family is in crisis, mostly due to the role of the man and father being blurred. St. Joseph is God’s gift to us – we have hope because there is a true holy and human role model that our youth, men and fathers can learn from. St. Joseph was chosen by God to look after Jesus and Mary and us, and to be the human role model for his Son and our men. So are our men chosen to be fathers, both biological and spiritual.

Nowadays, men are highly vulnerable to great spiritual risks. How to face them? The key antidotes to these risks are giving a truly solid Christian formation to our boys from the cradle, and youth and men turning back to God in the Sacraments, living a firm spiritual and family life as disciples of Christ, consecrating themselves to St. Joseph. Scripture shows St. Joseph as a man and father who is present – God knows best as usual, as current research shows that the importance of a father’s presence in a person’s life is immeasurable from childhood even through adulthood.

Interestingly, St. Teresa of Avila, herself the Doctor and Master of prayer had this to say of St. Joseph, her spiritual father: “*If anyone cannot find a master to teach him how to pray, let him take this glorious saint as his master and he will not go astray.*”

George Weigel expressed this on Pope St. John Paul II, who himself was a great model of fatherhood:

“The first inspiration came from his father. It was his father, Karol Wojtyła, Sr., who was the defining figure in his life as a boy, as an adolescent, and as a young man. A rather reserved gentleman, whose formal education ended in elementary school, a retired military officer of granite-like integrity, he was also, as his son later wrote, a man of ‘constant prayer’ who taught his son by example that the Church is more than a visible institution of which one is a ‘member’.”

Rincón de Espiritualidad *por Virginia Fraguio, OCDS*

San José: Padre de Padres

En Tierra Santa se encuentra la hermosa y humilde iglesia de San José ubicada muy cerca de la gran Iglesia de la Anunciación en Nazaret. La visité casi al año de que mi padre Carlos falleciera. Tiene una ventana colorida muy bonita que muestra la imagen de San José en su lecho de muerte acompañado por Jesús y la Virgen María. Me pareció ver a mi propio padre cuando falleció en paz como San José, bajo la mirada de Jesús y María. Me recordó tantos padres buenos que como José, el padre adoptivo de Jesús, y mi papá, dejaron una marca indeleble en todos aquellos que ellos cuidaron, por los cuales hoy estamos eternamente agradecidos.

El Padre Don Calloway, MIC escribe en su libro *Consagración a San José*: “La relación de amor entre un padre espiritual y su hijo perdura para siempre. En otras palabras, Jesús continúa siendo el Hijo de José en el cielo. Lo que vale para Jesús vale para nosotros. San José es nuestro padre espiritual para siempre. Así como él cuidó a Jesús en la tierra, San José te cuidará a ti en tu peregrinación en la tierra. San José es tu proveedor, educador y protector amoroso.”

Todos sabemos que la familia está en crisis, principalmente debido a que el rol del hombre y padre está desdibujado. San José es un don de Dios a nosotros y a nuestros papás – tenemos esperanza porque existe un modelo a seguir santo y humano de quien todo joven, hombre y padre puede aprender. San José fue elegido por Dios para cuidar a Jesús y María y a nosotros, para ser el modelo para su hijo. Así también nuestros hombres fueron elegidos para ser padres, tanto biológicos como espirituales.

Hoy en día los hombres y padres son vulnerables a grandes riesgos espirituales. ¿Cómo hacer frente a ellos? Los antidotos claves son dar una formación sólida Cristiana a nuestros niños varones desde la cuna en adelante, y que los jóvenes y hombres vuelvan a Dios en los Sacramentos, viviendo una vida espiritual y familiar como discípulos de Cristo, consagrándose a San José. Las Escrituras muestran a San José como un hombre y padre que estaba presente – Dios lo sabe todo, como siempre, porque investigaciones actuales demuestran que la importancia de la presencia del padre en la vida de una persona es inconmensurable desde la niñez hasta la adultez.

Es interesante ver que Santa Teresa de Ávila, Doctora y Maestra de oración dijo esto de San José, su padre espiritual: “Si alguien no puede encontrar maestro para enseñarle cómo rezar, que tome a este glorioso santo como su maestro y así no perderá su camino.”

George Weigel escribió sobre el Papa San Juan Pablo II, quien es considerado un gran modelo de la paternidad para muchos:

“La primera inspiración le vino de su padre. Fue su padre, Karol Wojtyła, Sr., quien fue la figura que lo definió en su vida como niño, adolescente, y joven. Un hombre reservado, cuya educación formal terminó en la primaria, un militar retirado con una integridad férrea; él también fue, como escribió su hijo luego, un hombre de “oración constante” quien le enseñó a su hijo con el ejemplo que la Iglesia es mucho más que una mera institución visible de la cual uno es miembro.”
