*Minutes of Meeting 20 on February 29, 2020 at Brown Hotel, Louisville, KY
The meeting held in Broadway Room B, at 4 PM.*

The meeting was called to order by President/Alternate Trustee: Bruce A. Buehler at 4:01 PM with members present.

President Buehler stated that we own the mold. David Jessel made a motion to have more Pins made, seconded by Russ Devenney and was passed unanimously.

President Buehler is looking for a new Webmaster for the Website for which the contract that was renewed in 2019. After much discussion and identifying the template for our page uses Go Daddy. V.P. Bredenfoerder and David Perkins, CT will work out the procedures and institute the Newsletter publication.

Newsletter – Secretary Gunn offered to submit material for the revised newsletter.

President Buehler and David Jessel lead a discussion on the subject of a trip to Germany to visit the Zweibrücken Cemetery there. More input is needed between now and any booking.

The topic of Youth Program support was broached by President Buehler. After some general discussion David Jessel made a motion 2nd by Dan Woodruff to provide \$500 to Germany USO; \$1000 to the National JROTC Fund; and \$1000 to National Operating Fund of the Joseph S. Rumbaugh Historical Oration Contest.
