- \$74K in cash, \$29K in investments
- dues will be raised in 2019 to \$250 to help fund the dredging of the pond 6 by 2020 could cost as much as \$120K
- Accounts Receivable end of 2017 \$4K
- 196 homes in the allotment officers dues are waived, invoices are sent to 192 homes
- established a \$500 threshold of outstanding dues. If balance owed is \$500 or greater a lien will be filed against the home. The lien will stay in effect until the balance is paid or property is sold
- currently, 2 liens are in effect. process is starting for 2 additional homes

- maintenance of the ponds is the responsibility of the HOA
- AquaDoc is again doing the maintenance for the ponds -
- Prince Landscaping
- grates are being replaced with stainless steel on average one grate a year
- 2017 was an uneventful year for the ponds
- Pond 6 has a lot of sediment due to the bank of the pond
- this sediment will have to be hauled out when the pond is dredged
- do not currently have the funds to dredge Pond 6 in 2018
- Dues will increase to \$250 in 2019 to help build up funds for the dredging of the pond
- Mayfair East is \$415 (they have an outside management group)
- Raintree is \$275 (they have ponds)
- Hyde Park is \$150 (they have ponds)
