**First Lesson Isaiah 26:1-7** <u>1</u> In that day this song will be sung in the land of Judah: "We have a strong city; he sets up salvation as walls and bulwarks. <u>2</u> Open the gates, that the righteous nation that keeps faith may enter in. <u>3</u> You keep him in perfect peace whose mind is stayed on you, because he trusts in you.<u>4</u> Trust in the LORD forever, for the LORD GOD is an everlasting rock.<u>5</u> For he has humbled the inhabitants of the height, the lofty city. He lays it low, lays it low to the ground, casts it to the dust.<u>6</u> The foot tramples it, the feet of the poor, the steps of the needy."<u>7</u> The path of the righteous is level; you make level the way of the righteous.

Second Lesson Hebrews 1:1-8 <u>1</u> Long ago, at many times and in many ways, God spoke to our fathers by the prophets, <u>2</u> but in these last days he has spoken to us by his Son, whom he appointed the heir of all things, through whom also he created the world. <u>3</u> He is the radiance of the glory of God and the exact imprint of his nature, and he upholds the universe by the word of his power. After making purification for sins, he sat down at the right hand of the Majesty on high, <u>4</u> having become as much superior to angels as the name he has inherited is more excellent than theirs. <u>5</u> For to which of the angels did God ever say, "You are my Son, today I have begotten you"? Or again, "I will be to him a father, and he shall be to me a son"? <u>6</u> And again, when he brings the firstborn into the world, he says, "Let all God's angels worship him." <u>7</u> Of the angels he says, "He makes his angels winds, and his ministers a flame of fire." <u>8</u> But of the Son he says, "Your throne, O God, is forever and ever, the scepter of uprightness is the scepter of your kingdom.
