Father Absence *The Impact*

 1 out of 3 live in homes without biological fathers*

 90% of homeless and runaway children

 85% of all youths in prison

 71% of all high school dropouts

 120% at greater risk to become a subject of child abuse

 85% of children with behavior disorders

 63% of youth suicides

x7 times more likely to become pregnant as a teen

Father absence has shown to lead to:

-  rates of depression
-  life expectancy
-  rates of divorce
-  average income
-  rates of substance abuse
-  job security
-  educational performance
-  level of health

40% of children in father-absent homes have not seen their father at all for at least a year
