

Why Suffering is Increasing 2 of 2

Some have been compromised from within by Satanists and Masons, Communists, and at large have lost the faith. However, a tiny underground segment of the church is still alive and authentic. They are turned off when they see and hear that, but for those who doggedly pursue the truth and want to go deeper, to live what Jesus taught, the gates of Hell have not prevailed and the glorious riches of the faith are there for those who care nothing for the opinions of men, who ridicule you when you want to go deeper and those who seek only the Lord and practice what He taught. If you are one of those, you will go deeper until you really are satisfied that you have embraced the truth.

He knows all the hidden darkness and sins of our lives but loves us to utter distraction. He rescues us from the murky waters of men's ideas and guides us through crocodile infested waters and through the filthy marsh of Satan's lies about you are a hopeless failure and about Jesus being a mean and unmerciful God. What most do not understand is in the Old Testament that God was merciless with those who tortured and ate their babies, sacrificing them to Baal and doing the unthinkable with animals. For the sake of his body, the Church: Nothing is lacking in the sufferings of Christ, but believers who form a single reality with Him (His body) prolong and complete His Paschal Mystery of Death and

Resurrection by their trials and sufferings.

In summary dear ones, these Scriptures say it all and explain why things are so extremely hard in our lives right now. Do not give in to discouragement because we are on the final lap and awfully close to the Rapture. But it does make sense that when the end came closer things would get harder, they must, to release graces for the lost before it is too late. Yes, our sufferings release graces, which is why we fast. Grace is the gift of God, but it is released through our generous participation in His suffering. Here is the Scripture:

2 Corinthians, Chapter 4

The Gospel of the Glory of Christ. 1. Therefore, since we are engaged in this ministry through the mercy of God, we do not lose heart. 2. Rather, we have renounced all shameful and hidden ways. We do not engage in deception or falsify (OR MODERNIZE-I am adding) the word of God. 3. If our gospel is veiled, it is veiled to those who are perishing, 4. those unbelievers whose minds have been blinded by the god of this world.

For instance, prosperity gospel-That everything is ok, you should never be sick, you should always have everything you need. The prosperity gospel-Blinded by the god of this world to prevent them from seeing the light of the gospel of the glory of Christ, who is the image of God.

5. We do not proclaim ourselves. We proclaim Jesus Christ as Lord and ourselves as your servants for the sake of Jesus. 6. For the God who said, "Let light shine out of darkness," has enabled his light to shine in our hearts to enlighten them with the knowledge of the glory of God in the face of Jesus Christ.

7. However, we hold this treasure in earthen vessels so that it may be clear that this immense power belongs to God and does not derive from us. 8. We are afflicted on all sides but not crushed, bewildered but not sunk in despair, 9. persecuted but not abandoned, struck down but not destroyed. 10. We always carry around in our body the death of Jesus, so that the life of Jesus may also be manifested in our body. 11. For in our lives we are constantly being given up to death for Jesus' sake, so that the life of Jesus may be revealed in our mortal flesh. 12. As a result, death is at work in us, but life in you.

And as Franciscans, how many times have we been ridiculed for our vow of evangelical poverty? Which merely means that we reject the superfluidity of the modern world in order to have more of Jesus, more time with Him, more ability to work for Him.

He continues and says, 16. Therefore, we do not lose heart. Even though our outer self is continuing to decay, our inner self is being renewed day by day.

And, you know, I cannot tell you how many times- I know my physical body is getting older, I am surely aware of it, but I feel so young, I feel like I am in my twenties. It is a beautiful thing, and that renewal is coming from my relationship with the Lord and His Word and how many people think that Christians should always be perfect? Have an exciting and fun-filled life, with all kinds of possessions and abilities to do all kinds of recreational things? And they look at the ones that are poor and sickly and think of them as the underprivileged, the ones who did not make it into the good life of Christianity. They are still on the outside, they just do not have the faith, or whatever the assignment is to their motives.

What a lie that is!

17. Our temporary light afflictions are preparing for us for an incomparable weight of eternal glory,
18. for our eyes are fixed not on what is seen

Not on the things of the world, the accumulations, the privileges, the lifestyles, but on that which cannot be seen. What is visible is transitory; what is invisible is eternal.

And these quotes are partially from the NCB Bible, the New Catholic Bible which I have not done a thorough study of what is in this Bible but – so please do not take it literally, I have much to learn yet what is in it, but it seems to me that it is going in the right direction.

Dear ones, we are on the verge of our incomparable weight of Eternal Glory, we must keep our eyes fixed on what cannot be seen, that which is invisible is eternal, we are approaching the Rapture, and allowing our Sweet Jesus to take as much as He needs from us to save those He weeps for.
