



ROCAME JAMBOREE COMPETITION CATEGORY

Free Expression Event (Power Point)

Description: The contest is for each school system to present the best power point presentations from their respective school system. Each school system is allowed one middle school team and one high school team.

Number of Participants: 1 presenter and 2 contributors per county Middle School team
1 presenter and 2 contributors per county High School team

Approximate time: No more than five minutes.

Event Competition:

The regional presenters will gather in the designated location for the Free Expression event and will be informed of their individual start times. **The student team should introduce themselves and give the title or focus of their presentation.**

1. Projects may be completed individually or in groups
2. **Entries should be no more than five minutes total run time including credits.**
3. **PowerPoint presentations should include auto run features. The student(s) should expand or comment on the subject presentation and particular slides. Do not just read the slides.**
4. Entries must adhere to all copyright guidelines as outlined at <http://www.ncpublicschools.org/copyright1.html>
5. All sources should be properly cited.

6. Names of all people (parents, teachers, students, etc.) who assisted in the project are to be listed in the credits specifying the jobs that each person performed. Name(s) of each student(s) is/are listed specifying the jobs that each student performed.
7. Final products should be submitted via CD or USB drive.

Judging Criteria

Content: (Maximum of 20 points)

- Submission includes evidence of your ROCAME chapter's values and activities
- Information is clear, appropriate, and correct
- Mechanics (spelling, grammar, etc.)

Creativity/Originality: (Maximum of 10 points)

- Consistent format
- Creative/artistic use of elements
- Presentation is entertaining and informative

Design/Layout : (Maximum of 15 points)

- Submission includes a logical organization
- Submission includes effective use of text elements
- Submission includes effective use of space and color
- Submission includes effective use of sound
- Pacing is appropriate

Credits/Works Cited: (Maximum of 5 points)

- All works are cited properly
- All sources properly cited
- All team members and support persons credited

First, second, third place awards will be presented to each middle school team event winner and each high school team event winner.
