One thing that makes Moe's unique is that they greet each person who walks in the door with a unanimous "Welcome to Moe's." A friend of mine says he likes going there simply for that reason. He says it feeds his ego. My reason for liking Moe's is the good food - I think.

As I thought about my friends reason for wanting to eat at Moe's I also thought about why we participate in all the things that require our time, energy and money. I thought of the walk to Emmaus. Why do we come back to serve on Emmaus walks? What is it that compels us to drive that long and winding road, pay money, sleep in rickety beds, take frosty showers, listen to the foghorns while we sleep and walk up that muscle killer hill fifty times a day (Or at least what feels like fifty times a day)?

The answer for me has always been clear - God. It must be the experience of God calling us to do things and go places that we ordinarily would not entertain under any other circumstances. I have had people who have never been on an Emmaus walk quizzing me about why I served. For some it was clear that my behavior was too much for them to comprehend. If you think in logical and comprehensible terms it is too much. If you think with the mind of God, it is perfectly understandable.

As we look at eleven walks during the year 2004, we need to remember that it is God who calls us and God who will equip us. He simply needs willing vessels with humble hearts. He always takes care of all the other details. Let us be especially aware of God calling us to serve in this year before us and be willing to offer ourselves to Him through service in the Emmaus Community.

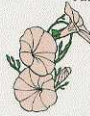
