

New Vienna City Council Meeting
April 24, 2019

Mayor Pat Hermsen opened the meeting at 5:30pm. Present were council members: Roger Langel, and Jim Naber, Kathy Engelken, Mike Leuchs. Absent- T.J Kloser.

Leuchs made the motion to approve the agenda for April 24, 2019 seconded by Engelken.

Naber made the motion to approve the consent agenda, bills, receipts, financial reports, Seconded by Leuchs.

Maggie Burger from Spear Financial present to go over the bond bids the City received today on the Community Center project. Maggie explained the bids and the procedure to the council and opened the floor for questions and concerns. The city received three bids on the project.

Resolution #12-2019 -RESOLUTION PROVIDING FOR THE SALE OF GENERAL OBLIGATION CORPORATE PURPOSE BONDS, SERIES 2019 was approved on a motion from Naber, Second by Leuchs, Ayes: Langel, Engelken, Leuchs, Naber. Absent- Kloser.

Building Permit for Aaron and Krista Erzen for a fence was approved on a motion from Leuchs, second by Naber. Ayes-all.

Maggie Burger from Spear Financial went over financing options for the water pressure project. The council received information on State Revolving Fund vs. local financing. Discussion included loan options, utility fees usage increase vs. debt loan repayment fee. Maggie will contact the engineer and get clarification on the questions from the council regarding the DNR permit, reports that will need to be submitted. Maggie recommended the SRF loan is the cities best option in the long run.

Discussion on the delinquent utility accounts, the clerk stated that they will be shut off due to lack of payment and larger balances. The clerk will contact the police dept. to deliver the shut off notice.

The Mayor will contact US Cellular on the placement of the pole for cell service to see if they have a different option for placement as this one presented is not ideal.

The can redemption will be moved to the city shed behind J & D Mart due to the limited space by city hall that needs to be reserved for the hall rentals.

There being no further business to discuss the meeting was adjourned on a motion from Leuchs, second by Naber at 6:40pm.
