Purpose

Chapter newsletters are a vital component in the GWRRA communication chain. An excellent newsletter will provide clear, comprehensive information to the Chapter's participants so that they are kept up to date on happenings within the Chapter, District and GWRRA. The purpose of the Chapter Newsletter Award is to provide recognition to and honor a Chapter Newsletter Editor/Chapter Director whose newsletters are considered outstanding by the District.

The Chapter Newsletter Award is based on newsletters from the calendar year. The same Chapter is not eligible to win the Chapter Newsletter Award in two consecutive years.

Judging Guidelines

There is no requirement for a specific format, and each Chapter is free to choose how they wish to format their newsletter. The newsletter submitted for consideration may be in color or in black and white, and it must be the same newsletter that the Chapter members receive.

Keep newsletters to a reasonable length. This will encourage readers to read through the entire newsletter and will reduce postage and reproduction costs.

Chapter newsletter shall be submitted to the District Membership Enhancement Coordinator (MEC) each month. To qualify for the competition the Chapter must submit a newsletter each month. The preferred method for submitting a Chapter Newsletter is via email. Chapter newsletters can be submitted to FLDistrictMEC@tampabay.rr.com. Newsletter can also be submitted via regular mail.

Scoring guideline are in enclosure 1.

Process

- Chapter submits newsletter to District MEC monthly (example: February newsletter must be submitted during the month of February)
- A District panel will judge each newsletter and maintain scores
- Winning Chapter will be announced annually at the Florida District Chapter Conference
