FUN FACTS

- What is the altitude of Cascade Idaho?
Elevation from Idaho Falls to Cascade.
Elevation of Idaho Falls is 4719.5 feet or 1438.5 meters and the elevation of Cascade is 4761.81 feet or 1451.4 meters, which is a difference of 42.31 feet or 12.89 meters. Idaho Falls, ID, USA elevation.
- What is the elevation of Cascade Idaho?
Cascade is a rural city in and the county seat of Valley County, Idaho, United States, in the west central part of the state. It sits at an elevation of 4780 feet (1457 m), along the North Fork of the Payette River.
- How many candy canes are made each year?
Over 1.76 billion candy canes are made each year. The biggest candy cane ever made was 36 feet 7 inches 51 feet long (see this news). Candy canes are sometimes as a topping for foods such as ice cream or as an additive to drinks such as hot chocolate. They are hung as decorations on Christmas Trees.
