AWAKE: The Call to a Renewed Life

Nothing refreshes like a good night's sleep. And who doesn't enjoy the occasional afternoon nap?

In at least one way, though, sleep is no good for us. In fact, it can be dangerous. I'm talking about being spiritually asleep.

Life has a way of lulling us to sleep spiritually. If we allow

ourselves to settle into a spiritual snooze, after a while we simply die spiritually.

Our greatest need as believers is to experience a spiritual renewal from God, and that's the whole point of this study. I must warn you, though: this is not a study for those who want to maintain the status quo. When the Holy Spirit begins to bring renewal in our lives, things will change.

We will look at several places in the bible where God called people to return to Him. It's a call for us, too—a call to experience revival and awakening personally and in our churches. As people have turned back to God, He has done extraordinary things and sparked great movements. Wouldn't you like to see God do that again? Join me on the journey of asking God to bring about the next great movement of renewal and turning back to Him.
