"Springing Into Spring"

I have been spending time learning with Mary DeJong, founder of the group, The Waymarkers in the practice of



"re-wilding". This practice is a prayerful, sacred way of marking the seasons of the year and what is happening all around me in my own bioregion and homescape. It is the practice of noticing — plants, animals, climate, changes... it is the practice of connection to the nature in the place where I have chosen to put down my own roots. It is a practice of Earth-Centered Spirituality that has really been bringing me to new life. This month, the month of true greening and change; the month of Earth Day observances and celebrations, I thought I would share a few reflection questions for Spring which Mary has shared with me.

- What is a desire you carry into this Spring season? How many longings can you give language to that capture the essence of that which you seek? What is peeking through your soul-scape, much like a crocus poking through the warming soil? What is growing? What is emerging? What feels new and inspired in you?
- What seasonal shifts do you notice in your bioregion?
- How are the wildlife behaving in your homescape?
- What is lengthening in you this Spring? What is emerging in fresh and new ways?
- Who do you notice? Sink deep into your senses and even into the spring time soil. Who is present within this warming Spring-time earth? How do the lengthening rays of Spring sun hit your earth?
- Plant a seed in a small clear votive candle holder or a small jar, fill it with rich soil, place it in an east-facing window. Watch it grow. Notice it.
- Sacred Sit Spot Find one place in your natural world that you visit all the time and get to know it as your best friend. Find a spot near water, shelter, and food for wildlife that you can get to easily and often without damage to a fragile landscape and with little danger of predators or other hazards. Let this be a place where you learn to sit still alone, often, and quietly. This will become your place of intimate connection with nature. **And if mobility is an issue for you, pick a window in your home and observe the nature immediately outside it.
