Preferably matted on heavy board or framed with secure wires or hooks. **DO NOT USE TAPE OR GLUE**, as this does not stand up to the heat in the building. HCF will not be responsible for damage done to work that is not properly mounted.
9. All entries must be brought to the Arts and Crafts Building on Sunday, August 6th from 1:00-4:00.
10. Work must be picked up from the Arts and Crafts Building on Monday, August 14th, from 4:00-7:00 with exhibitor ticket identification.
11. Awards will only be given when entries are deserving. HCF reserves the right to not award an entry if it is not high quality, or is the only entry in the category.
12. All entries may be used by the HCF for publication, marketing or social media purposes; appropriate acknowledgement of the artist will be noted.
