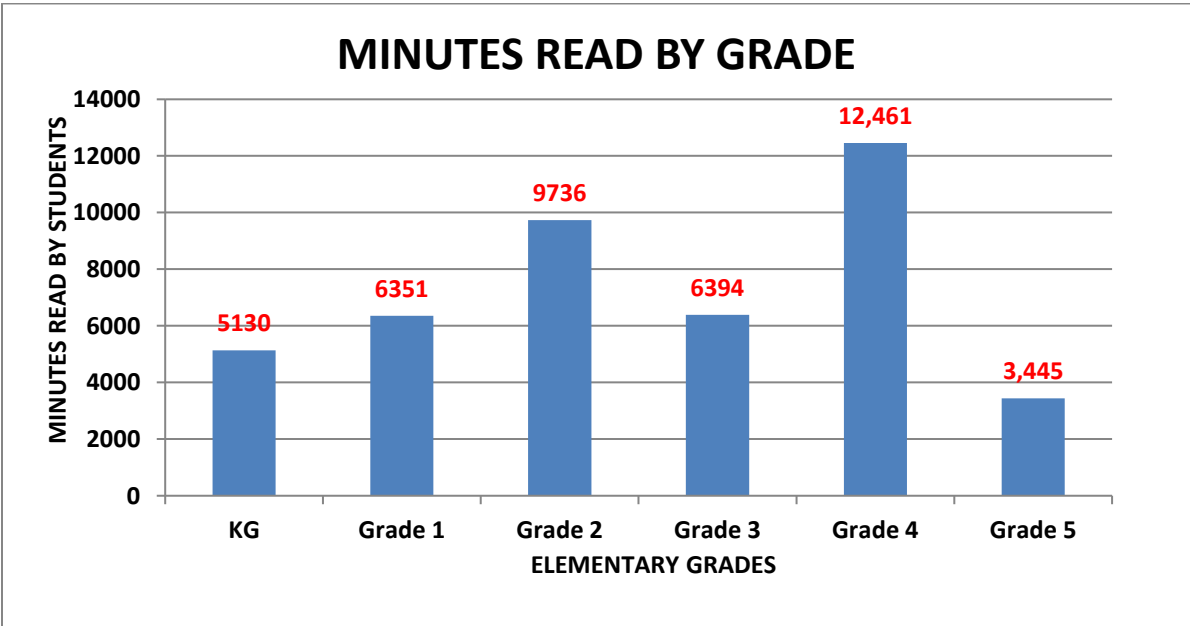
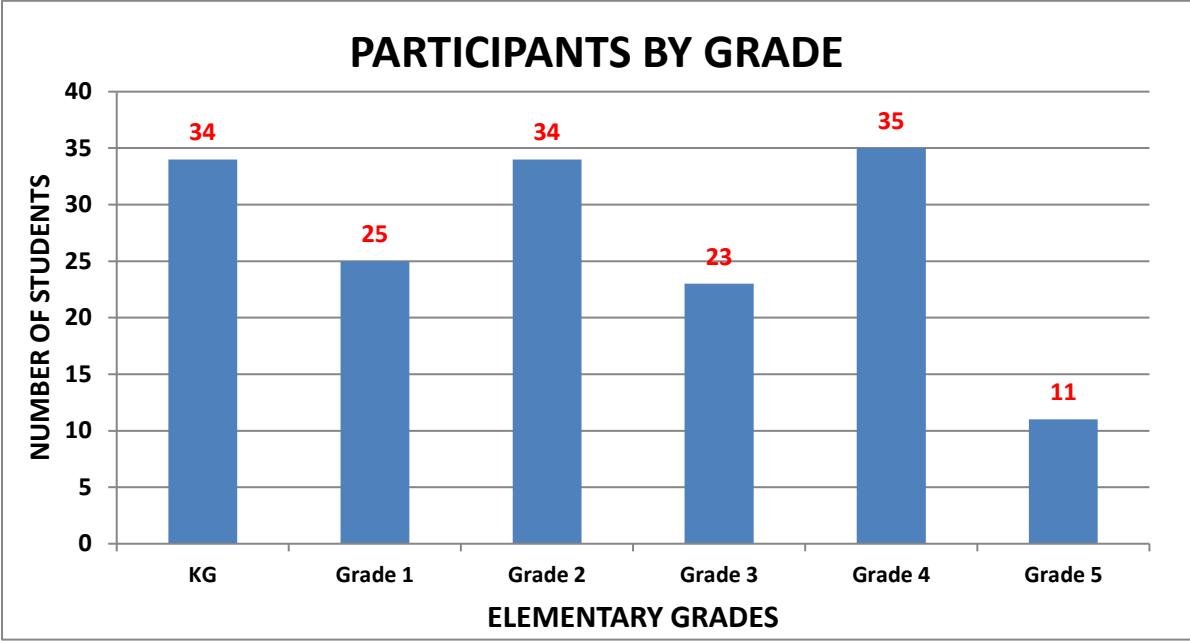
Number of Students participated: 162
