### Food Drive October 14th/15th to Benefit The Sheridan Story

For school-aged children the weekend should be something to look forward to. Now imagine you're one of 200,000 children in Minnesota who live with food insecurity—your weekend paints a different picture. Without reliable access to food, such as meal programs at school, the risk of hunger is very real.

The Sheridan Story is an ever-growing network of weekend food programs, commonly called 'backpack programs,' operating in multiple schools providing students with a bag of non-perishable food to take home from school for the weekend. Each bag consists of an average of 4.6 lbs. of food.

**On the weekend of October 14th & 15th,** we'll be collecting nonperishable food for The Sheridan Story's backpack program. Items needed are:

- Canned tuna or chunk chicken (6oz. or less)
  - Canned vegetables & fruit
  - Canned soup, & stew
  - Canned beans, chili, & ravioli
  - Boxed or bagged rice, pasta, and oatmeal
- (It is best if all food items are under 16 oz.)*

Monetary donations are greatly appreciated! Checks payable to St. Cecilia with a notation of "The Sheridan Story" may be placed in the regular collection basket.
